## Overall impactReduced milk sales- €65,656Reduced costs+ €45,352OFS payment+ €20,600

## Take home messages

- Organic may suit farmers with existing low stocking rates
- Premium for organic milk is currently low
- Reduction in costs and OFS payment deliver main benefit
