Infrastructure: review and prioritise



- 105 Cows on 43 ha of heavy land
- Spring 2018 extremely difficult grazing
- May 2018 infrastructure review
- Large areas poorly serviced by roadways or access from roadways
- On heavy soils, all paddocks should be within 50 m of a roadway/spur road

Infrastructure required

- New roadways (4 m wide × 1120 m)
- Spur roads (2 m wide × 615 m)
- Reconfiguring of paddock boundaries
- Additional water troughs
- Improved road surfaces throughout

Works Completed-2018



Costs

- <u>€1000/ha</u>
- Included roadways, spur roads, piping, troughs and fencing

Benefits

- 30 grazings in Feb. 2019
- 60% grazed by April 1st
- Extra milk solids
- Less labour required
- Less silage/meal
- Less slurry
- Each extra day grazing
 - €3/cow in spring
 - €2/cow in autumn
