## Producers in the Bioeconomy The All Island Biomap



The BioMap is a project developed by Irish Bioeconomy Foundation and funded by Intertrade Ireland. The objectives of the Biomap are to map out organisations that have potential synergies between companies and increase cross border collaboration between NI-ROI organisations. So far, we

have documented 561 organisations on the Island of Ireland that are relevant to the bioeconomy. We have mapped 418 organisations that are based in the Republic of Ireland (ROI), and 143 organisations are based in Northern Ireland (NI). The organisations have been classified into the following categories:

- 1. Industry sectors such as Agri-Tech, Diary, Brewery etc.
- 2. The various feedstock used across the provinces.
- 3. Size of Employment.
- 4. Types of products produced by various companies.
- 5. Types of organisation.
