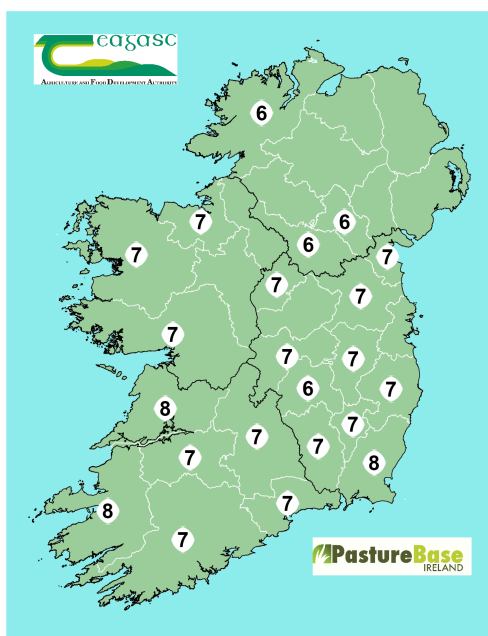

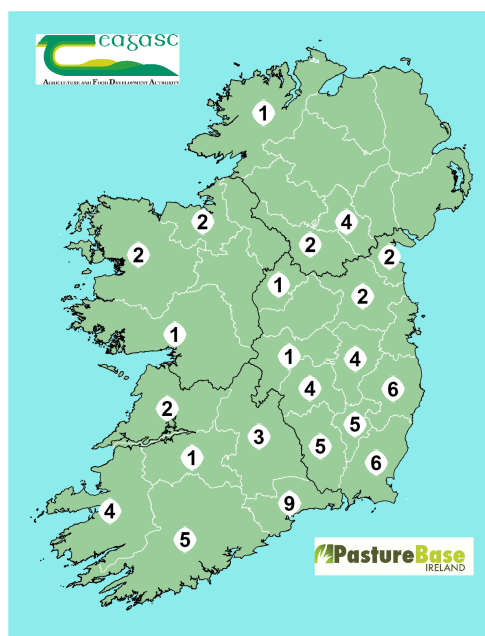

next week



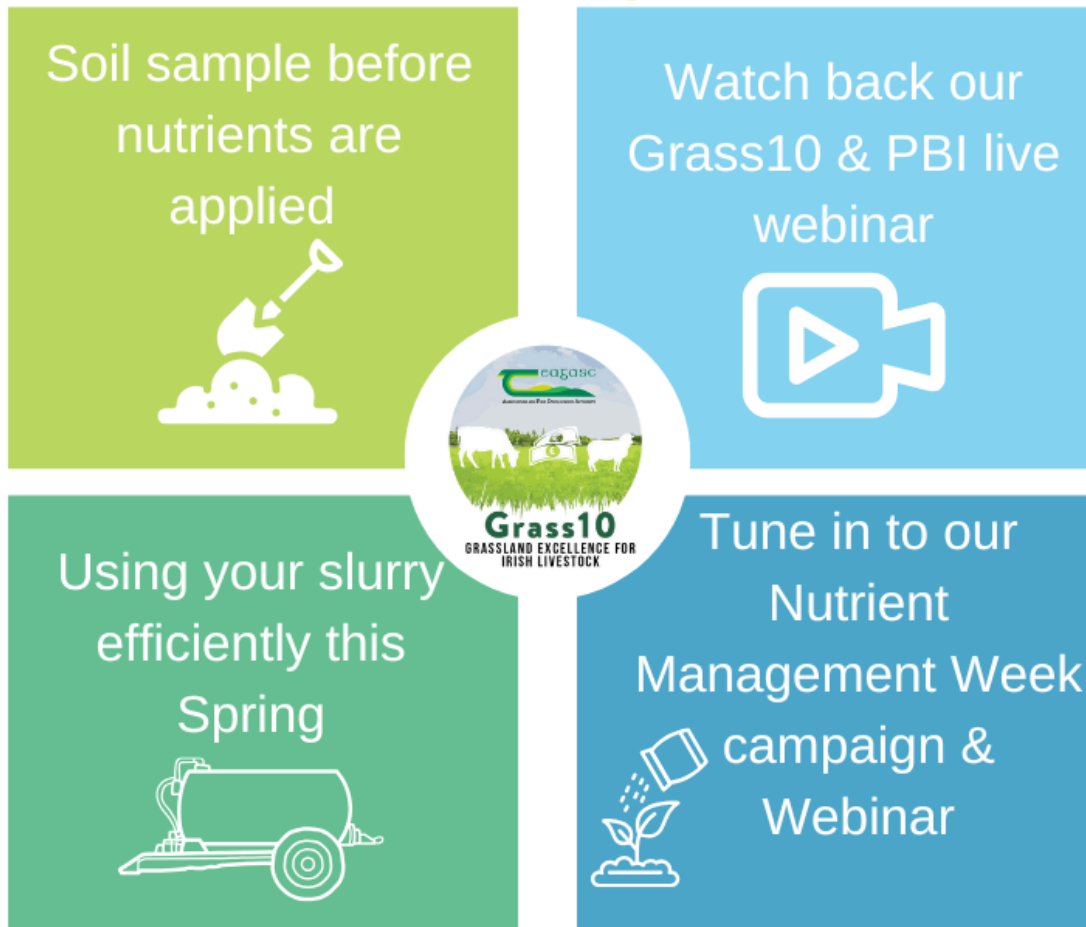

# Grass10 Weekly Checklist



## Soil sample before nutrients are applied

- Take advantage of good soil sampling conditions currently to get your annual soil samples completed
- Take a sample every 2-4 Ha, walk in a 'W' pattern to get a representative sample and keep away from drinking troughs, ditches and field entry/exits
- Ensure full cores are taken of 4" (10cm) to get an accurate analysis of pH, P & K

## Using your slurry efficiently this Spring

- The prohibited period from spreading organic manures has passed for farms in Zone A (13th January). Zone B will be permitted to spread organic manure from this Thursday, January 16 and Zone C from Saturday, February 1
- If spreading slurry target low soil index (1 & 2) paddocks. The level of slurry application spread should be at a rate of max. 2000 gal/acre of

dilute cattle slurry. It is important to adhere to buffer zones and weather warnings

- The updated guide values for organic manures below value 6% DM slurry at about €25 per 1000 gallons so the efficient use of it on Irish farms is essential
