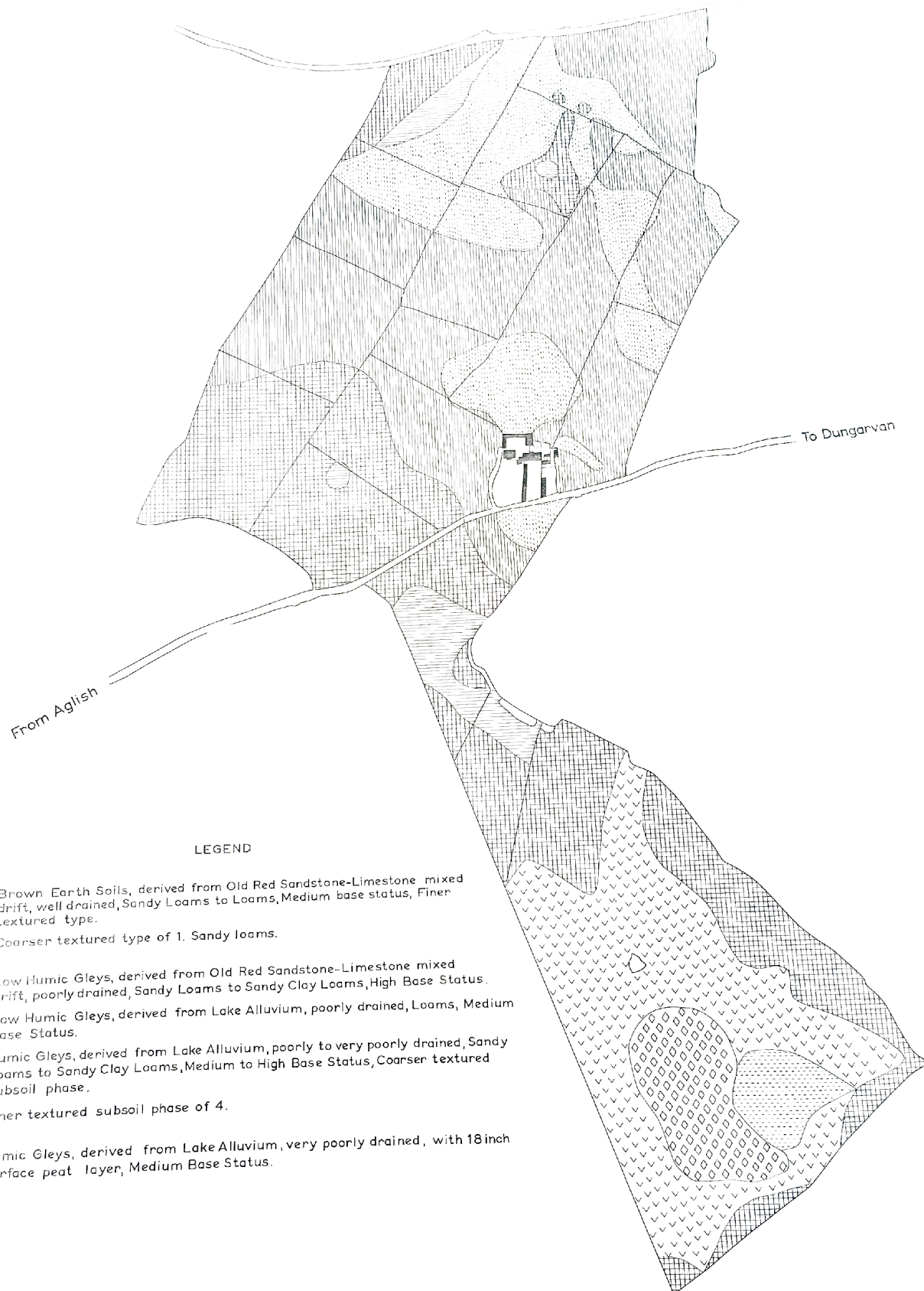


# Apple Research In Teagasc
