

Biosecurity is essential to protect your business from harmful diseases. The following checklist will aid in helping you keep your birds and livelihood protected.

Building Maintenance



- () Is your roof structually sound?
- Is the house free from water ingress?
- Is the house well ventilated?
- () Is the site clear of vegetation & debris?
- Is the site free of pooled water?

Bedding



- Is additional bedding in a covered store?
- Have bales been disinfected before being brought into the house?
- Have all vehicles or equipment been disinfected before entering the house?

Rodent Control



- Is there an effective rodent control in place?
- Are feed spillages cleaned up immediately?
- Have all holes/cracks been repaired?

Staff



- () Is house specific clothing available for all staff?
- () Avoid sharing staff between sites
- Is regular biosecurity training provided?
- Are step-over barriers in place and used correctly?

Visitors



- Are only essential visitors permitted site access?
- Is a visitor log being maintained accurately?
- Are all visitors shown the biosecurity plan? Is disposable PPE available for all visitors?

Vehicles



- Is designated off-site parking available for essential vehicles?
- For vehicles which must come on-site, is there appropriated cleaning and disinfecting facilities?
- Are drivers of vehicles made aware of the biosecurity measures before coming on-site?
- Is a log maintained of all vehicles coming on site?

Site Access



- Is the site gates and doors locked at all times? Is the foot-dip changed frequently?
- Is the correct disinfectant used, and at the correct dilution rate?
- Are foot-dips covered from rain?
