



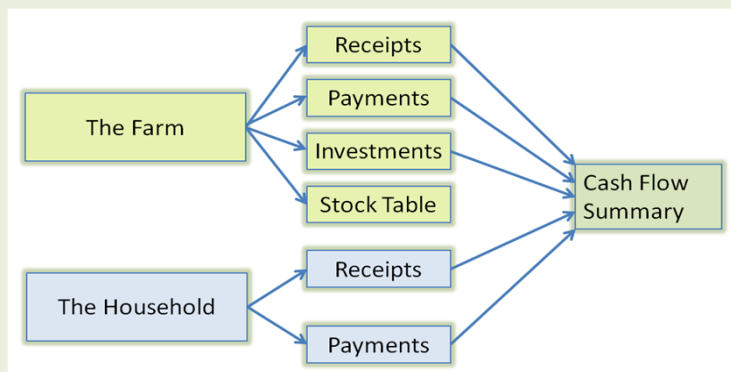

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Introduction

This money management workbook has been designed to help you to manage your finances in a structured fashion. The workbook is divided into two sections, one for the farm and the other for the farm household.



How to use this workbook

- 1 Record all farm receipts each month in the farm receipts section
- 2 Record all farm payments each month in the farm payments section
- 3 Record all farm investments each month
- 4 Record all farm livestock movements each month
- 5 Record all household receipts each month
- 6 Record all household expenditure each month
- 7 Transfer all the monthly totals to the summary page inside the back cover
- 8 Use the data recorded to make a basic budget for the next year
- 9 Use the farm data recorded over the year to complete a Teagasc eProfit Monitor to measure your farms performance for the year

Cash flow is the movement of money in and out of a business
