

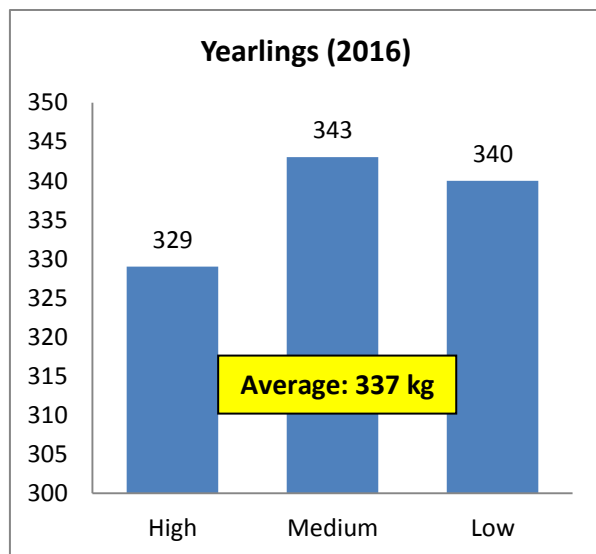
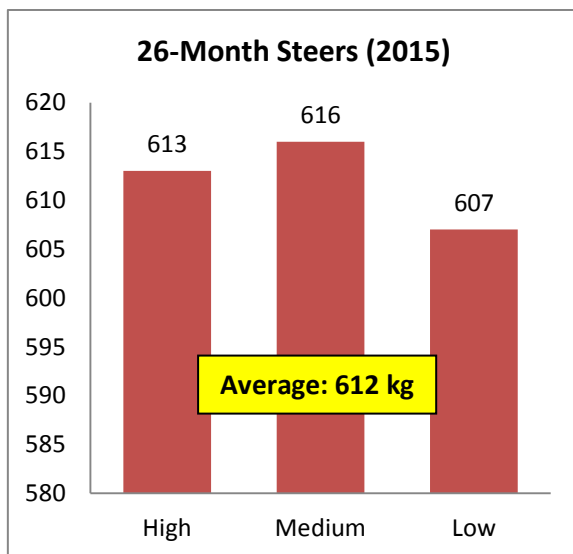
Teagasc Johnstown Castle Teagasc/ABP Dairy Beef Research Programme

Update: 16-05-2017

- Grass growth had slowed down due to a prolonged dry spell. However, this week will see increased growth with the rain over the last number of days. Cover to be taken 18-05-17.
- 26 month steers supplemented with 2.5kg/head/day since 4th May.
- More paddocks assigned for early first cut silage.
- No health issues of animals at grass.

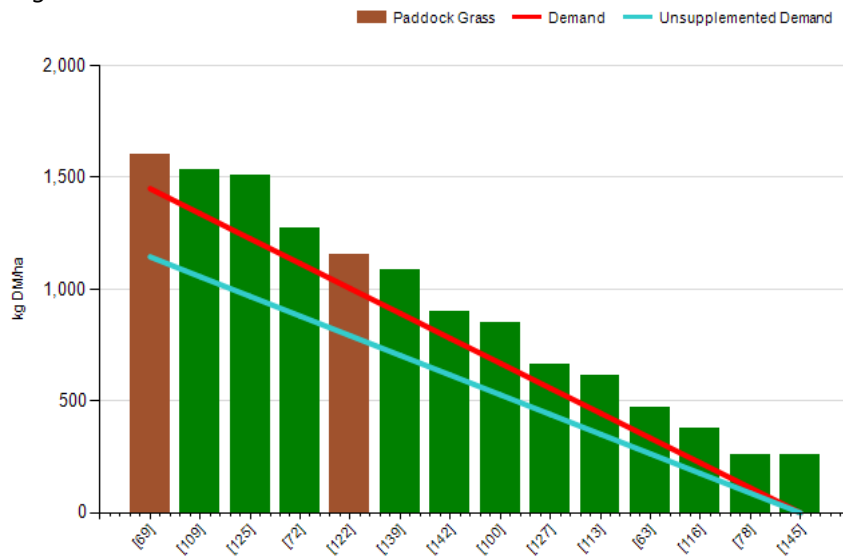
Cover: 11-05-2017

- Rotation length: 21 days
- Pre-grazing yield: 1450kg DM/ha
- Livestock: 72 1-2 year old (310kg), 18 >2 year old (590kg) animals per farmlet.
- One strong paddock cut and exported to Johnstown Castle dairy farm (paddock 79, low).

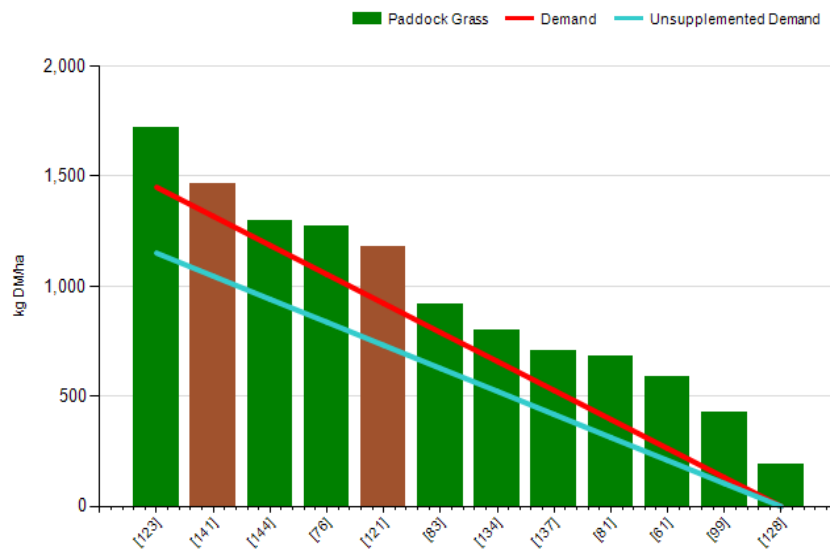
