## Teagasc Johnstown Castle Teagasc/ABP Dairy Beef Research Programme

#### Update: 01-06-2017

- Conditions for May were relatively dry, with the middle of the month seeing a prolonged dry period which reduced grass growth. Grass growth has since risen with the increased rainfall.
- Yearlings continue to graze swards (~1500kgDM/ha) without concentrate supplementation.
- 26 month steers supplemented with 2.7kg concentrates at grass.

### Animal Performance

- 26 month steers to be killed 6<sup>th</sup> June. Pre-slaughter back fat scanning and liveweight to be measured 2<sup>nd</sup> June.
- One yearling had to be brought to factory due to broken shoulder.
- Reared calves from ABP receiving second dose of Huskovac next week. They will come to Johnstown the middle of June.

### **Grassland Management**

- Rotation length: 21 days
- Livestock: 72 1-2 year old (310kg), 18 >2 year old (590kg) animals per farmlet.


- Silage pre-cuts taken on the 30<sup>th</sup> May for DM and chemical analysis.
