Animal performance:

Weanlings

- Weanlings performance improved
- Were being fed 73 DMD pit silage ad lib and 2kg concentrates.
- From 13th February concentrates reduced to 1kg/head/day.

26 Month Steer System

- Performance had been poor in December- underwent investigation
- Were being fed ad lib surplus baled silage, approximately 71 DMD. Now changed to pit silage.
- Being fed high P and Se general purpose beef minerals with silage.

Health:

Weanlings

- Weanlings dung and blood sampled in December, approx. two weeks after Closmectin administration.
- Blood samples clear, however dung samples showed high levels of strongid worms.
- Suggests resistance to wormer. All calves subsequently given white dose down the neck.
- Will be dosed for Blackleg before they go out to grass.

26th Month Steer System

- Dung samples came back clear.
- Blood samples showed Selenium deficiency.
- Suggested that the deficiency may be due to high Nitrogen in levels the baled surplus silage.
- Silage test results showed severely low levels of Se and low levels of other trace minerals.

• Selenium injection administered to animals as per vet recommendation. Animals switched to pit silage with selenium mineral powder supplementation.

Grassland management:

- Farm cover taken week of 20th February.
- Weanlings and steers to go to grass as soon as weather permits.
