Animal Performance:

Older cattle

- The steers were weighed on the 5th February, they averaged 589 kg. There is huge variation with the lightest bullock 428 kg, while the heaviest is 706 kg.
- We had two casualties over the last ten days- one bullock had to be killed as he was a TB reactor, while another broke its leg and had to be put down.
- Other than that, the health of the bullocks is excellent, with no pneumonia.
- The bullocks are being fed 30 kg silage (fresh weight) and 2 kg concentrates.

Yearlings

- The yearlings remain on 14 kg silage and 2 kg concentrates.
- They are performing well and it is hoped to get them out to grass mid February. They were weighted on the 5th February and averaged 326 kg.
- Since last week the yearlings have been increased to 17 kg silage (fresh weight) and 2 kg concentrates.

Grassland Management:

- A farm cover was completed on the 4th February. Since the last cover there had been a few sharp frosts, meaning there was minimal growth. There was a reduction in covers on some of the more exposed paddocks.
- Fertiliser spreading began yesterday (5th Feb). KAN is being spread at a rate of 65kg/ha on any paddock that has not received slurry.


• Although it has been wet, ground conditions remain good. It is still hoped to get the lighter cattle out in the next 10-14 days weather permitting.


High stocking rate farmlet
