Farmer comment from Stephen Mc Auliffe:

- Cows and incalf heifers are in full time now with over a week, weanlings will be housed this week
- We have had one case of mastitis in the past week
- We had a 9% empty rate after 12 weeks of breeding, we've culled some of these plus 5% poor performers
- The remainder of empty cows will be sold at dry off time
- We do selective dry cow on cows for anything under 100scc, all cows get sealer and are fed hay for two weeks post dry off

Adviser Comment from John Mc Carthy:

- Examine milk recording records to identify cows suitable for selective dry cow therapy
- Plan to give first Lactation cows and thin cows a minimum of twelve weeks of a dry period to rest
- Test your silage for quality and mineral content as soon as possible
- This simple, cheap test will help make informed management decisions over the winter period
- Remember to complete a minimum of 20 grass covers in 2023 to comply with nitrates derogation rules
