Farmer comment from John Casey:

- Farm cover increased last week so took out a paddock to bring cover to 942Kg DM average farm cover
- The cows were scanned and had 11% empty
- Seeded 1.6Hectares this week after drainage works completed on it, lime & dung will be spread here
- Young stock had challenges with 30 calves getting signs of pneumonia requiring treatment
- Half the milking platform got a tonne of lime in the spring, will spread the rest of the platform shortly

## Advisor comment from Deirbhile Browne:

- Grass growth rates are high for September with very good weather conditions currently
- Check rotation length (35 days for mid September). Make sure average farm cover isn't getting too far ahead of target
- Cattle Slurry spreading ends by October 1<sup>st</sup> and FYM on November 1st
- Take advantage of the good conditions to spread Lime and K if necessary based on valid soil samples
- Days at grass in the autumn is worth €2.50 per LU approx
