Demonstration farmer comment from Diarmuid Fitzgerald: Farm cover is ok at 177 cover per cow. We have cut the meal to 0.5Kg per cow. The 22 acres we reseeded in April which includes white clover and red clover was given post emergence spray this week and is due for its second grazing in the coming week. Cows are not scanned yet but repeats seem normal. About half of the clover paddocks are getting no nitrogen and the other half are getting 10units of nitrogen per month.

Advisor comment from Claire Mc Auliffe: Grass growth is now back up over demand on most farms following rainfall, this will allow grass covers to recover. Grass may still get stemmy as it will be stressed following the dry period. The target grass cover is 160 to 180 kg DM/cow. Remove surplus grass where possible or correct paddocks that were poorly grazed. Ensure that a total of 15 units of S per acre are applied in the May to July period. Paddocks that were baled need P and K replaced on them. Where 4 bales were removed these need 1500 gallons of slurry per acre.
