## **Farmer comment from Alex Mc Carthy:**

- Cows out by day with help of multiple access points and back fencing in by night since Wednesday
- We dried off ten low yielding heifers at the weekend seven of these got teat sealer only
- We have sold three cull cows
- The in calf heifers and weanlings came in last week to be housed full time
- Silage stocks are good and sample results have been good despite the tricky weather at harvest times

## **Adviser Comment from Anthony O'Connor:**

- Keep grass in the diet where possible, if there are any heavy covers, try to get these grazed out
- Clover paddocks should be grazed before closing to allow light into the base of the sward over winter
- Review Dry periods in cows. Target 10 to 12 weeks for first calvers and 8 weeks for cows
- Monitor body condition score. Aim to dry off animals in the same condition you want them calving down in
- Test your silage for the winter ahead to plan and formulate the diet for the winter
