Demonstration farmer comment from John Casey: Cows are in by night now. There are 27 cows dried off at this stage. I still have between 13-16 grazings still to graze. The covers in those paddocks range from 1300 to 1700 kg DM/ ha. We assumed 11% DM to calculate those grass covers. I housed a few of the smaller calves as I thought they were losing condition. I will be vaccinating the cows and heifers for IBR and Lepto in December and January. I aim to do selective dry cow therapy on at least 10% of the herd this year.

Advisor comment Claire McAuliffe: Grazing has stopped on most farms, which has been dictated by ground conditions. Average Farm Cover should range from 500 to 600 depending on stocking rate on November 15 to reach the closing average farm cover targets on the 1st December. Selective approach to drying cows off, Teagasc suggests that cows with an average annual SCC of less than 100,000 cells/ml and no clinical cases of mastitis could make suitable candidates for drying off without dry cow antibiotics. Having cows in the correct body condition score (BCS) of 3.0 to 3.25 (fit but not fat) at calving is essential for trouble-free calving next year. The process starts in late lactation. The primary tools for BCS management in late lactation are dry period length and feed intake/quality.
