Demonstration farmer comment from Stephen McAuliffe: Average farm cover is good at the moment and I am happy with current performance from the cows as well. There is still no silage in their diet. We scanned them recently and had an empty rate of 9.5%. There is currently around 45% of the land closed and the heavier covers are being grazed on drier days. If rain continues the cows will go in by night. I hope to have the calves and in-calf heifers out until late November. There is plenty of silage in the yard. There is approximately 25% of a buffer of silage in the yard from last year. We plan our silage requirement as if there is no buffer so we should have no issues.

**Advisor comment Tim Doody:** Monitor cow condition score. If cows are below target body condition score (2.75) dry them off earlier. We are now 13 weeks away from February 1<sup>st</sup>. Consult with your vet if you haven't done so already and identify suitable cows for selective dry cow therapy. Now is the time to be preparing cows for dry off. Clip tails as soon as possible. Finally adhere to the autumn planner. The target is 60% of ground closed on November 1<sup>st</sup> on dry ground and 80% on heavier ground.
