Demonstration farmer comment from Niall Moloney: I am happy with my farm cover now and am expecting next week's to be something similar. Supplementation with silage stopped a week ago. I have an autumn rotation planner complete and am planning to be finishing grazing in mid-November at a cover of 600 to 700 kg DM/ha. For my clover swards, I am planning on grazing them late and carrying a low cover on them over the winter. The will help maintain clover in the sward.

Advisor comment Adrian Bourke: All dairy farmers should begin closing paddocks this week with the aim of having 60-70% of the farm closed by the 1st of November on drier farms and 80% on heavier soils. Famers should try to graze heavier covers on drier days, keeping silage out of the diet when doing so. Farmers should maintain the level of meal being fed and monitor lactose levels in the co-op tests, not leaving them go below 4.30%. A reminder that the deadline day for spreading farmyard manure is 31st of October; targeting low P and K index fields. Now is the perfect time for spreading lime on paddocks that have a pH lower than 6.2
