



- Our forests keep growing...
  - Over 4 million m³ of roundwood timber harvested in 2022 (CSO,2023)
  - By 2035 will increase to 7.9 million m³ (COFORD, 2021)
- Forest owners indispensable link in timber supply chain... sustainability is central
- Must have confidence and reassurance

  - DAFM support










## to sum up..

## **Prioritise Health and Safety**

- Code of Practice for Managing Safety and Health in Forestry Operations (Health and Safety Authority)
  - Sets out legal duties for forest owner, forestry works manager and contractors e.g.
- Site specific & operational risk assessments
- Safety Statement
- Emergency and contingency planning
- Health and safety monitoring
