'Sheep 2018: Farm to Fork' is a major sheep event being held at Teagasc, Mellows Campus, Athenry, Co. Galway on Saturday, 7th July 2018 starting 10.00am and finishing at 6.00p.m. With a positive outlook for sheep, it is appropriate that all parties interested in a viable sheep industry come together with the common aim of capitalising on the potential that sheep production offers. While this event is of major interest to all involved in the sheep industry it will also appeal to those with an interest in rural affairs.

This year, to tie in with Galway having been awarded the **European Region of Gastronomy** designation, there will be a significant emphasis on food. This will be hosted in a specially designated Food Village.

'Sheep 2018: Farm to Fork' is the major sheep event in the agricultural calendar for 2018 and is an event that everyone with a commercial interest in sheep will want to attend.

There will be a comprehensive programme, in booklet form, covering all activities and this will be distributed free of charge to all patrons attending. The costs of the event will be covered by money received from a small number of major sponsors, together with a number of minor sponsors, a modest fee for stand space. Admission is free.
