Ears	Pointing back	Scared or aggressive	
	Drooping	Relaxed or resting	
	Pricked upward	Alert and interested	
	Turning and pivoting	Listening to what is going	
		on and to rider's instructions.	
TaiL	Tucked down	Danger at the rear of the horse.	
		Threat of kicking or bolting.	
	Swishing	Annoyed by flies or another horse.	
		Annoyed by actions of it's rider.	
Head	Tossing	Irritated and may bite or kick.	



HORSE BLIND SPOTS

Be sure to only approach a horse at their shoulder. The front and back are typical blind spots and startling a horse can result in getting a kick!

COWS and BULLS


When anxious, cattle may attack when they feel there is no other option. Watch out for cows with calves and all bulls!


To help prevent diseases ALWAYS wash your hands after visiting a farm or handling animals.
