What is cow flow?

 Cow flow is the movement of a herd of cows <u>to</u> and <u>through</u> the milking parlour from where they have been feeding and resting. This movement needs to be <u>smooth</u> and <u>efficient</u>.



Cow Track

- Width (fenced 0.5m from edge)
- Surface
- Camber



Collecting Yard / Milking Parlour

- Yard
- Size (1.5m sq-1.8m sq)
- Shape
- Surface
- Backing gate
- Parlour
- Natural light
- 90°turns
- Surface
- Milking routine



Human Interaction / Behaviour

- Droving the cows from the field (cows heads up / heads down)
- Moving cows in and out of parlour
- Farmer's behaviour during milking



Summary

- Observe cow flow at a distance (cows heads up / heads down)
- Check your track
- Look in the mirror (Selfreflection)
