

- 2) Submit a 2021 BPS (Basic Payment Scheme) application online closing date 17th May 2021

Step 7: Start Organic Conversion

Enterprise	Conversion period
Livestock Systems (grass based)	2 Years
Arable and Horticulture	2 Years (only crops sowed after the conversion period has elapsed achieve full organic status)


