




Ireland's Ranking in Europe







Energy Use in Ireland



Heat Use in Ireland




Graphical distribution of electricity, natural gas, oil and peat (incl. turf and coal) used for heating

- 57% of all gas-heated households are in Dublin
- Mid and West Ireland are strongly reliant on oil and peat for heating due to low connectivity to national gas infrastructure




Incentives

- SEAI Support Scheme for Renewable heat!
 - Investment aid of up to 30% for air-sourced, ground-sourced and water-sourced heat pumps
 - Operational aid based on heat use on a annual basis
