External Biosecurity:

- Purchase of one-day-chicks
- Purchase of laying hens
- Depopulation of the poultry houses
- Feed and water
- Transport of eggs
- Removal of manure and carcasses
- Visitors and farmworkers
- Material supply
- Infrastructure and biological vectors
- Location of the farm

Internal Biosecurity:

- Disease management
- Cleaning and disinfection
- Materials and measures between compartments
- Egg management
